### **HEALTH AND SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

#### The HAMS Guide to Safe Shooting

- Never Aim Your Gun in an unsafe direction
  - Whatever you are doing never aim your gun at another gun or in an unsafe direction. Whether you're turning to ask advice or walking from one stand to another, your gun must be broken.
- Know your shooting area
  - Make sure you are familiar with the shooting ground. HAMS provides a printable map to ensure everything is clearly marked.
- Be aware
  - Always be aware of where other shooters are
  - Always take a moment to look around
  - Always know where your fellow shooters are
- Always treat your gun as if it is loaded!
- Whoever hands you a gun
  - Open it, check it and make sure the chambers are empty and the barrels clear!
- When passing a gun it must always be proved empty:
  - ∘ Open
  - Empty
  - Passed stock first showing the empty chambers
- Broken & Unloaded
  - When your gun is not in use it must always be broken and unloaded.
- Only load your gun when you are on the stand and the muzzle is pointed toward the firing zone.
- When not in use and out of the slip, guns should be broken and held with the muzzle pointing either straight up or straight down
- Broken at all times!
  - When you're on a shooting ground all over-unders and side-by sides should be broken at all times (the only exception is when the unloaded gun is safely away in its slip).
- Only load the gun when you're on the stand
  - Only load the gun when you are ready to fire and ensure the muzzle is pointing ahead toward the firing zone

- Never turn on a stand with a loaded gun.
  - Break it first and unload it.
  - Don't make U-turns. Inexperienced shooters sometimes fire the first shot then turn to advice from fellow shooters. A big NO.
- Never leave cartridges in the gun when it's not being used
- Keep your gun in your gun slip
  - If it's not in a slip it should be broken.
- It's hard for other shooters to tell if a semi-auto or pump action is loaded or not.
- Know the law
  - If in doubt check, ignorance is not an excuse


